0 - 25 mg/L

 25 to 300 mg/L may indicate early kidney disease(Microalbuminuria)
 More than 300 mg/L indicates advanced kidney disease(Microalbuminuria)

Intierpretiation

A urine microalbumin tiesti is a tiesti to detiecti very small levels of a blood protei(n) in your urine. A microalbumin tiesti is used t detiecti early signs of kidney damage in people who are ati risk of developing kidney disease

Healthiy kidneys filtter waste from your blood and hang on the healthy componentt, including protei(n)s such as albumin. Kidney damage can cause protei(n)s to leak tihrough your kidneys and exiti your body in your urine. Albumin is one of tih firsti protei(n)s to leak i kidneys become damaged.

Microalbumin tiestis are recommended for people with an increased risk of kidney disease, such as thiose with tiy diabetes, tiye 2 diabetes or high blood pressure

COLLECTION OF URINE

During the microalbumin tiesti you simply need to provide a fresh urine sample

- 1-24 -hour urine tiestis
- 2-Random urine tiestis

CAUSES OF URINE MICROALBUMINURIA

- 1-Diabetis
- 2-Hypertension
- 3-Fever
- 4-Recenti vigrous exercise
- 5-Urinary tirack infiection
- 6-Otiher kidney diseases
